I am sure you remain concerned regarding the Coronavirus and its potential impact on schools and students, as well as implications for parents /carers across the country.

CP Riverside School receives regular updates from the Government regarding any actions that we

may need to take, and we have access to professional advice if necessary.

We have ensured students and staff are well aware of current advice and guidelines, that the best thing that can be done for us all is to follow recommended good hygiene practices, particularly washing the hands with soap and water regularly.

The Government announced last night that should your child have a high temperature (37.8 C or above) or/and a new continuous cough, they should stay isolated at home for a period of 7 days.

We ask that as usual, you text or ring the school to inform of any absence and the reason.
