This year has been another odd year for our year 11 cohort with the examinations being cancelled.

As you are aware from the media and information from school, we have submitted teacher assessed grades to the Examination Boards to enable grades to be formulated in readiness for Results Day on Thursday August 12.

We would therefore like to invite your child to collect their results on 12 August between 10:00 – 12:00.

It is preferable if they could collect their results in person. However, a parent/carer may collect on their behalf but they have to be in possession of the enclosed Candidate Permission Form signed by your child.

Any results slips not collected will be emailed to you after this date.

GCSE examinations are scheduled to run between Monday 1 November and Thursday 2 December.
